together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto be'onging or in any wise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the foregoing premises to the said R. C. Grason
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said Harriet Company
for and his heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said R. C. Grason
and his heirs, successors and assigns, that he is lawfully seized in fee of the foregoing premises; that
they are free from all incumbrances, that he have good right to sell and convey the same to the said R. C. Grason
as aforesaid; and that he will and his successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
fend the same to the said R. C. Grason
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
