

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

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THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 18th day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twelve, by and between Garrett Company, a single man, of the first part, and Lynde-Bowman-Darby Company, of Evans, Indian Territory, part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1) Dollar and other valuable considerations, DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

East Half of Northwest Quarter, and Northeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter of section Three (3), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of Indian Road and Meridian,

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Lynde-Bowman-Darby Company, and assigns, in fee simple forever; and the said Garrett Company, for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Lynde-Bowman-Darby Company, its heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said Lynde-Bowman-Darby Company, as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Lynde-Bowman-Darby Company, and its heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, wife of said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
