

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH CLERK'S INDEX NUMBER

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 15th day of July, one thousand nine hundred and four, by and between Ben Reese and his wife, Amanda Reese, of Chelsea, Indian Territory, part and of the first part, and W. H. Kornegay and S. G. Wills, of Indian Territory, part and of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part and of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Sixty-seven \$60.00 DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part and of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot 16 of section 16, Township 30 North, Range 13 East of the Indiana Meridian, containing 33.45 acres.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said W. H. Kornegay and S. G. Wills and their heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we the said Amanda Reese and Ben Reese for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said W. H. Kornegay and S. G. Wills that we are a recognized member and approved citizen of the Cherokee Nation and of Indian Blood and their heirs, successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrances, that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said W. H. Kornegay and S. G. Wills aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said W. H. Kornegay and S. G. Wills and their heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Amanda Reese, wife of said Ben Reese, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part and of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
