

# GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH ATTACHMENT OR EXHIBIT

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 26<sup>th</sup> day of March, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Beulah Brown Foster  
South Middle Indian Territory, of the first part, and John R. Thomas and Frank Lourman of  
Muskogee Indian Territory, part and of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand (\$100.00) DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, doth hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: the undivided one half interest of the said Beulah Brown Foster in the 160 acres of land allotted to the mother of said Beulah Brown Foster, Alice Shields deceased, described as follows: the south east quarter of Section Twenty (20) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twenty (24) East.

to have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said John R. Thomas and Frank Lourman and their executors, administrators, heirs and assigns, and their heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said Beulah Brown Foster her heirs and executors, administrators, heirs and assigns, that they are free from all incumbrances, that she has good right to sell and convey the same to said John R. Thomas and Frank Lourman, as aforesaid; and that she will and her successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said John R. Thomas and Frank Lourman and their executors, administrators, heirs and successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Frank Foster, of Pauls Valley, Indian Territory, wife of said Beulah Brown Foster, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
