

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RECITALS AND CERTIFICATE OF POWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 21st day of March, one thousand nine hundred and seventy,
by and between Lura Brown nee Armstrong of Adair, Indian Territory,
part of the first part, and George R. Smith
of Muskogee, Indian Territory,
part of the second part,

WITNESSETH, That that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other
valuable considerations,
to the other party, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
do as follows, hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: Land half of Northwest quarter of North east
quarter and North half of East and West quarters of North east quarter of section Ninety
(19) Township Sixty-one (61) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said George R. Smith
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said Lura Brown nee Armstrong
for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said
George R. Smith of Muskogee, Indian Territory and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that
they are free from all incumbrances, the that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said

George R. Smith as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said George R. Smith
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawfu' claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Lura Brown nee Armstrong, wife of George R. Smith, of Muskogee, Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
