

# GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

**THIS INDENTURE**, Made and entered into this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, one thousand nine hundred and seventy, by and between Annie C. Willis, and L. C. Willis, her husband, of Muskogee, Okla, part ix of the first part, and Lynnde-Brownman Dairy Company of Muskogee, Okla, part ii of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part ix of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part ix of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: All their interest in and to the northeast quarter of north west Quarter of Section Twelve (12), Township Nineteen (19) North Range Fourteen (14) East, of Indian Bar and Medicine, the homestead allotment of Robert Brown, deceased,

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Lynnde-Brownman Dairy Company, and its heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we the said Annie C. Willis and L. C. Willis, for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Lynnde-Brownman Dairy Company, and to heirs, successors and assigns, that we will lawfully seize in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrances, that we will have good right to sell and convey the same to said Lynnde-Brownman Dairy Company, as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Lynnde-Brownman Dairy Company, and to heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Annie C. Willis, wife of said L. C. Willis, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part ix of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
