

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 14 day of November, one thousand nine hundred and four
by and between Mary Vann
Hubert L. L. L. part 1 of the first part, and William E. Haskell
of Terre Haute, Ind. Ter. part 2 of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part 1 of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
Five Hundred & Forty DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 2 of the second part the following de-cribed real estate and premises situated in the
Shoshone Northern District
Mustang Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section (2) Township (20) North Range (13) East

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon to be'onging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said William E. Haskell
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said Mary Vann
for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said
William E. Haskell and his heirs, successors and assigns, that and he lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that
they are free from all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said
William E. Haskell as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
fend the same to the said William E. Haskell
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Mary Vann of Northern
wife of said Hubert L. L. L. for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby re-
lease and relinquish unto the said part 2 of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
