

## GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the undersigned,

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 2 day of November one thousand nine hundred and four  
by and between Frederick Wilson  
H. Gibson, his Son, party of the first part, and William E. Halell  
of Victoria, his Son, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of  
One hundred & fifty DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,  
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the  
Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:  
1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of N.C. 1/4 of Section 19 and 1/16 of SW 1/4 of Sec-  
tion 20 Township 20 North Range 44 East

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto  
To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said William E. Halell,  
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and as the said Frederick Wilson, Victoria Wilson  
for himself and wife, heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said  
William E. Halell and his heirs, successors and assigns, that he has no right to any land or property, Cherokee Nation,  
they are free from all incumbrances, that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said  
William E. Halell aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-  
fend the same to the said William E. Halell  
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the law's claims and demands of all persons  
And I, Victoria Wilson  
wife of said Frederick Wilson  
of H. Gibson, S.T.

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do her by re-  
lease and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

That he has not executed any deed, contract, instrument or other conveyance of any kind whatever  
to the lands described in this deed to any other person, partnership, or corporation.
