GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH REINFORCEMENT OF POWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and four,
 by and between Marybeth Sanders,
Wichita, Okl. party of the first part, and William E. Halell,
 party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part, of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
Three Hundred (\$300.00) DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
 do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part, of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
Cherokee Nation, Northern District, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:
1/8 of Section 4 of Section 2, Sup 20 North Range 18E; and N.E. 1/4
of Section 4 of Section 4, section 2, Sup 20 N., R. 13 E. containing 30 acres.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon to be ongoing or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said William E. Halell,
 and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said Marybeth Sanders,
 for ever, and her heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said
William E. Halell, that she will not, during her life, sell, transfer, alienate, or in anywise dispose of the same, or any part thereof, to any other person, party,
 and his heirs, successors and assigns, that she may lawfully seize in fee of the aforesigned premises; that
 they are free from all incumbrances; that she has good right to sell and convey the same to said
William E. Halell, as aforesaid; and that she will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
 fend the same to the said William E. Halell,
 and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawfu' claims and demands of all persons.

And I, wife of said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-
 lease and relinquish unto the said part, of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
