GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 21st day of May, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Sam Simon, a single man, of the first part, and O. L. Beppin, of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: South 1/2 of the south 1/4 of Sec. 21, T. 17, R. 15, South 1/4 of the south west 1/4 of Sec. 20, T. 17, R. 15, and the north 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 29, T. 17, R. 15 and the south west 1/4 of Sec. 11, T. 18, R. 13.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities therein belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

* To have and to hold the aforesaid premises in the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.

and heirs and successors in fee simple forever, and the said for and and heirs, executors and administrators to covenant with the said and heirs, successors and assigns forever against the law claims and demands of all persons.

* And I, the wife of said for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
