WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 14th day of Feb, one thousand nine hundred and Sever
 by and between L W Mathews Single
Vera J Et party of the first part, and E B Brown
Vera J Et party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty no/oo
 DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
 does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
 Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: Lot Eighteen(18) Block two(2)
of the Bryan addition to Vera

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto and warrant
 the title to the said land unto the said party of the second part heirs executors
 administrators and assigns forever
 and heirs and successors in fee simple forever and the said
 for and heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said
 and heirs successors and assigns that lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises, that
 they are free from all incumbrance
 that have good right to sell and convey the same to said
 as aforesaid and that will and successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
 fend the same to the said
 and heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

I and I, wife of said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do herby re-
 lease and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
