

# GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

**THIS INDENTURE**, made and entered into this 5th day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twelve, by and between S. B. Dawes  
Margarette, A. J. part of the first part, and David L. Sleeper  
of Tulsa, I.O. part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of  
One hundred (\$100.00) DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,  
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the  
Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The north half of the northeast 1/4 of northeast 1/4 of section  
18, Township 19 North, Range 10 East.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities therein to be ongoing or in otherwise appertaining thereto except all the oil  
and all the gas that shall be in and under the surface of the land and minerals being hereby reserved to greater

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said David L. Sleeper,

and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said S. B. Dawes,

his heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said David L. Sleeper,

and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that

they are free from all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said

David L. Sleeper as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-

fend the same to the said David L. Sleeper,

and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Margarette Dawes of Muskogee

wife of said S. B. Dawes, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do her by re-

lease and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
