

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH ACHIEVEMENT OF DOWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 8th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and four by and between Sarah Ward and her husband Ben Ward of Wimer, I. T. part 100 of the first part, and Edward Shanahan and Harry Mitchell of Venita, I. T. part 100 of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred DOLLARS, in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Cherokee Northern District Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

NW 1/4 S. W 1/4 Section 2 Township 21 N. R. 13 E

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises in the said Shanahan & Mitchell and their heirs and successors in fee simple forever; and we the said Sarah Ward and Ben Ward for Edward Shanahan and Harry Mitchell and their heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and defend the same to the said Shanahan & Mitchell and their heirs, executors and administrators, that we are entitled, lawfully possessed and apprised fullmen citizens of the Cherokee nation, and of Indian birth or Indian descent, that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said Shanahan & Mitchell they are free from all encumbrances.

T. Mitchell as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Shanahan & Mitchell

and their heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Ben Ward, wife of said Sarah Ward, of the second part, of the first part, having hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written,
