

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH AFFIDAVITMENT OF POWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 20 day of July, one thousand nine hundred and four,
 by and between Lizzie Regal,

 of Vinita, part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
Tours Hundred DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
do by hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
Cruske Northern District
Minicore or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:
50 1/4 of 700 1/4 of Section 3 Township 25 in Range 20 E. in C. 1/4 of S. 1/4 of
S. 1/4 Sect 34 Land 21 in Range 13 East.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said W. E. Haleell, Oliver Bagby
 and their heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and to the said Lizzie Regal
 for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said W. E. Haleell, Oliver Bagby
and they will not sell any part of the land or any right therein
and they will not allow any other person to lawfully seize in fee of the aforesigned premises; that
 they are free from all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said W. E. Haleell
& Oliver Bagby as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and
defend the same to the said W. E. Haleell & Oliver Bagby
 and they heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, wife of said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-
lease and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
