WITNESSETH, That that the said part is of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred
and fifty DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
Cherokee Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: South west quarter of north
west quarter and the south west quarter of the
south east quarter of the north west quarter of section
seven township twenty north range Thirteen east

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said John Orr
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever, and the said John P. Chandler and Susan
Chandler for themselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said John Orr
and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that
they are free from all incumbrance; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said John Orr
we aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
fend the same to the said John Orr

And I, Susan Chandler of Siloam Springs Arkansas
wife of said John P. Chandler for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-
lease and relinquish unto the said part of of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
