

## GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH ATTACHED INDEX NUMBER

**THIS INDENTURE**, Made and entered into this second day of May, one thousand nine hundred and seventy, by and between Harry Smith and H. Jeannie Smith his wife, of Muskogee, Okla, part of the first part, and

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Four Hundred \$400.00

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: East half (1/2) of the northwest quarter (1/4) and the south west quarter (1/4) of the northwest quarter (1/4) of Section Sixteen (16) township eighteen (18) north range fourteen (4) east of the P.M. containing one hundred and twenty (120) acres more or less according to the United States survey, together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities therein to be ongoing or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said William G. Martin, and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we the said Harry Smith and H. Jeannie Smith his wife, for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said William G. Martin, and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said William G. Martin; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said William G. Martin, and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, H. Jeannie Smith of Muskogee, Okla, wife of said Harry Smith, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
