THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 28 day of May, one thousand nine hundred and seven
by and between George Fields a creek freedman of Muskogee
part y of the first part, and Joseph J. Jones William
of McClary part y of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part y of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of \$2,000
Twelve Hundred DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part y of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The north west quarter (1/4) of the
south west quarter (1/4) in Section (6) six and east (1/2) one half
of the north east (1/4) one quarter of Section (8) eight all in
Township (10) eighteen north in Range (13) thirteen
east containing one hundred twenty acres more or
less and being my surplus lands of my allotment
together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon or in any wise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said Joseph J. Jones & William
and their heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said George Fields
for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Joseph J. Jones &
William McClary and their heirs, successors and assigns, that we lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that
they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said Joseph J.
Jones & William McClary will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
fend the same to the said Joseph J. Jones & William McClary
and their heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I George Fields of McClary for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-
lease and relinquish unto the said part y of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
