WITNESSETH, That that the said part one of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred  
DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,  
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part one of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the  
Muskogee Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The east half of lot two  
in Block eighty eight in the Original Town of Tulsa  
Creek Nation Indian Territory as shown by the  
Plat thereof.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto  
To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said J. H. Brown and V.E. Dodson  
and their heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said Ella Moore and Charles Moore  
for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said J. H. Brown and V.E. Dodson  
and their heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that  
they are free from all incumbrance, except all mortgages that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said J. H. Brown  
V.E. Dodson as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-  
fend the same to the said J. H. Brown and V.E. Dodson  
and their heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.  
And I, Ella Moore, wife of Charles Moore, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-  
lease and relinquish unto the said part one of the second part all my right, claim, or possible of Charles Moore  
as aforesaid; and the said part one of the second part claim of dower or homestead in said to the said lands in or out of the aforesigned
