**THIS INDENTURE**, made and entered into this 14 day of June, one thousand nine hundred and eleven, by and between Samuel E. Dunn and Lotta H. Dunn his wife, of Tulsa, Okla., part 100 of the first part, and Mary Louise Steel wife of John Steel of Bartlesville, Okla., part 1/2 of the second part;

**WITNESSETH**, That that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of five thousand DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 1/2 of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The south half of Lot Four in Block One hundred fifty three (153) according to the official plan of said City of Tulsa.

Said second party hereby assuming and agreeing to pay a certain mortgage on said property in the sum of one thousand dollars in favor of J. N. Givens

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Mary Louise Steel and her heirs, executors and administrators in fee simple forever; and to the said Samuel E. Dunn for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Mary Louise Steel and her heirs, executors and assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrances except said mortgage; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said Mary Louise Steel as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Mary Louise Steel, and her heirs, executors and assigns forever against the lawfully claims and demands of all persons, and for the consideration of said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 1/2 of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands for out of the aforesigned premises.

And I, Lotta H. Dunn, wife of said Samuel E. Dunn, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 1/2 of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands for out of the aforesigned premises.
