DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 1 of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: The west half (1/2) of the south west quarter (1/4), and the north east quarter (1/4) of the southwest quarter of section twenty six (26) township Eighteen (18) North, Range 14 (14) Fourteen East of the Indian Base Meridian.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises or the said Harry L. Stevens,and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said John Tigerfor his heirs, executors and administrators to covenant with the said Harry L. Stevensand his heirs, successors and assigns, that he is lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; thatthey are free from all incumbrance; that he has good right to sell and convey the same to said Harry L.Stevens; as aforesaid; and that he will and his successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Harry L. Stevensand his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.And I, Loris a Tiger of Momis G.T., wife of John Tiger, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 2 of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said part 1 of the first part have hereunto set their hands and seal, the day and year first above written.
