

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 9th day of July, 1907, one thousand nine hundred and Seven
by and between Moses O. Fields of Collinsville Indian Territory part 4 of the first part, and J. W. Steen
of Cherokee Indian Territory part 4 of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part 4 of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
One thousand (\$1000.00) DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 4 of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
Cherokee Western District of the Cherokee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the NE 1/4 of the
SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 27, Township 22 North Range 14 East -
East of the Indian meridian,

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises unto the said J. W. Steen
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and 2 the said Moses O. Fields
for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said J. W. Steen
that I am a recognized, engaged and approved citizen of the Cherokee or Creek Nation
and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that
they are free from all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said J. W. Steen
as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
fend the same to the said J. W. Steen
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Hella Fields of Collinsville Indian Territory
the wife of said Moses O. Fields, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-
lease and relinquish unto the said part 4 of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
