THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 24th day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between O. J. Parks and his wife Laura Parks, of Dallas Texas, part six of the first part, and Moses Roberson, of

part four of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part six of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred
No 100 DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part four of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: The north East quarter 7
the Northwest quarter of section twelve (12) Township Nineteen (19)
North and Range Fourteen (14) East

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto, possession to be given January 1 - 1908

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Moses Roberson and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we the said O. J. Parks and Laura Parks for, and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Moses Roberson and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said Moses Roberson aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Moses Roberson and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawfu claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Laura Parks of Dallas Texas, wife of said O. J. Parks, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part four of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
