

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF POWER

COMPARED

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THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this thirtieth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and 7,
by and between Willie Grayson,
Boggs Ind Ter. part 4 of the first part, and E. W. Lanning,
Muskogee Ind Ter. part 4 of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
Six hundred fifty 700 DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
do ex hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: North west quarter (NW 1/4) of South west
quarter (SW 1/4) of section twenty (20) Township 19 north Range 14 East
of Indian Base Meridian.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises of the said E. W. Lanning
and his ^{and assignee} heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said Willie Grayson
for myself ^{and my} heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said E. W. Lanning
and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that
they are free from all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said
E. W. Lanning as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said E. W. Lanning
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the law's claims and demands of all persons.

And I Willie Grayson wife of said E. W. Lanning for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
