together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said O. M. Lancaster and L. M. Brown
and their heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said William S. Tsurman and Jessie L. Tsurman
for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said O. M. Lancaster and
L. M. Brown and their heirs, successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that
they are free from all incumbrances; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said O. M. Lancaster
and L. M. Brown as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said O. M. Lancaster and L. M. Brown
and their heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Jessie L. Tsurman, of Okmulgee, Okl.,
the wife of said William S. Tsurman, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-
lease and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
