

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

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THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 17th day of July, one thousand nine hundred and Seven, by and between Frank C. Hailey of Broken Arrow Indian Territory, part of the first part, and Fred Buckley of Broken Arrow Indian Territory, part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand

(3000.00)

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: The north west quarter of Section twenty township eighteen Range fourteen

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities therein belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Fred Buckley and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said Fred Buckley for his heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Fred Buckley and his heirs, successors and assigns, that he lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that he has good right to sell and convey the same to said Fred Buckley; as aforesaid; and that he will and his successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Fred Buckley and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Henrietta Hailey, wife of said Frank C. Hailey, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
