

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RECITALS OF POWER.

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THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 16th day of July, one thousand nine hundred and

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Hundred

\$ 00/100 DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do E hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part Y of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: The north half of the north west quarter of section thirty-two and the north east quarter of the north east quarter of section three, being 67 1/4 acres in township fifteen of north and Range twelve (12) east of the P. O. M in Indian Territory containing 30 acres more or less as the case may be according to the United States Survey thereof

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Thomas A. Spae
 and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said Dawn Company
 for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Thomas A. Spae
 and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that
 they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said Thomas
A. Spae as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-
 fend the same to the said Thomas A. Spae
 and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, wife of said Y, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-
 lease and relinquish unto the said part Y of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
