WITH RECITALS AND CERTIFICATE OF POWER.

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 17th day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seven
 by and between Neoma Hasko, being the daughter
and one of the heirs of Richard and Mary Hasko, husband of Samuel Skelton,
husband of Neoma Hasko, of the first part, and L S Skelton,
of Muskogee, Okla, of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the

Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: all our right title and
 interest in and to the south half of the south east
 quarter and the south east quarter of the south
 west quarter of Section Thirty one (31) and the
 south west quarter of the south west quarter of
 Section Thirty one (31), together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon to be ongoing or in any wise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said L S Skelton,
 and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we the said Neoma Hasko and Samuel Skelton,

for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said L S Skelton,

and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises, that
 they are free from all incumbrance;

as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said L S Skelton,

and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawfull claims and demands of all persons.

And I,

wife of said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do her by release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
