WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWERS.

**THIS INDENTURE**, made and entered into this 17<sup>th</sup> day of July, one thousand nine hundred and Seven, by and between John H. Atkins, being one of the sons and heirs of Richard Atkins, deceased of Sharpe, part of the first part, and L S Skelton of Oklawholgee, Indian Territory, part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part Y of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do E hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part Y of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: all my right title and interest in and to the south half of the south east quarter and the south east quarter of the south west quarter of Section thirty one (31) and the south west quarter of the south east quarter of Section thirty two (32) falling in Township eighteen (18) of the third十三  
part of the Creek East Bank and bounded as follows: Beginning at the tree standing at the south east corner of the south west quarter of Section thirty two (32) and running thence west along the south east boundary line of the south west quarter of Section thirty two (32) for a distance of one hundred and thirty feet to the tree standing at the south east corner of the south west quarter of Section thirty two (32) and thence running north along the south east boundary line of the south west quarter of Section thirty two (32) for a distance of one hundred and thirty feet to the point of beginning; together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said L S Skelton and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and in the said John H. Atkins for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said John H. Atkins and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said L S Skelton as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said L S Skelton and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawfull claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Adalikins, wife of said John H. Atkins, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part Y of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
