

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH ALL INDENTURES, OR COUNTERPARTS,

THIS INSTRUMENT, Made and entered into this 26<sup>th</sup> day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seven  
by and between Alberd Tiger & Diciey Tiger his wife  
Okanulgee, Okla., partis of the first part, and Henrietta Bedleman  
and Mary E. Verson, partis of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said partis of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand  
\$100

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said partis of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: the south east quarter of the northeast quarter, the north east quarter of the south east quarter of Section Twenty-one (21) and the west half of the south west quarter of Section Twenty-two (22) Township nineteen (19) and Range Thirteen (13) E. of the Indian Grade and Meridian in the Indian Territory, together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Henrietta Bedleman and Mary E. Verson and their heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we the said

for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Henrietta Bedleman and Mary E. Bedleman and their heirs, successors and assigns, that we lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that

they are free from all incumbrance; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said Henrietta Bedleman and Mary E. Verson as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Henrietta Bedleman and Mary E. Verson and their heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Diciey Tiger wife of the Alberd Tiger wife of said

, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said partis of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
