GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF POWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 19th day of July 1907, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Dennis T. Ross and Mary Ross his wife, of Collinsville Indian Territory, part ^{one} of the first part, and Asbury M. Stephens of Collinsville Do part ^{one} of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part ^{one} of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred \$800,

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part ^{one} of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the unincorporated town of Collinsville Cherokee nation Indian Territory, town Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot 2 two and 3 three Block 4 four, according to the Government survey of said town. The parts of the second part to abut on the unpard government appurteances, improvements, hereditaments and appurtenances together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurteances and hereditaments thereon to belong or in anywise appertaining thereto. To have and to hold the same unto the said party his heirs and assigns forever and the said parties hereby covenant and agree with the said second party that at the execution and delivery hereof the first parties are the owners of the above described premises free and clear of any incumbrances whatever they are free from all encumbrance that have good right to sell and convey the same to said and heirs, successors and assigns that lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises; that and heirs, successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title to the said real property and will forever warrant and defend the title to the said real property to the second party his heirs and assigns against all claims or acts of the first parties and those of all persons claiming by through or under them. And I,

wife of said _____ for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party ^{one} of the second part all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
