

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of July, one thousand nine hundred and ~~teen~~ <sup>one</sup>, by and between John Davis and Lucy Davis his wife, of the Cherokee Indian Territory, part of the first part; and W. S. Fears, of Broken Arrow, Ok., part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part, of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of

One (1<sup>00</sup>)

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part, of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

South east quarter of the said east quarter  
of Section twelve (12) Township Eighteen north range  
Fourteen east containing forty acres being the  
homestead of Tommie Davis, deceased

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon to be ongoing or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said ~~John Davis and Lucy Davis~~  
~~executors and administrators~~ <sup>and</sup> ~~heirs and successors~~ in fee simple forever; and we the said ~~John Davis and Lucy Davis~~  
~~for ourselves and our~~ heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said ~~John Davis and Lucy Davis~~

and ~~his~~ heirs, successors and assigns, that we lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that  
they are free from all incumbrance; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said ~~John Davis and Lucy Davis~~  
as aforesaid; and that we will and ~~our~~ successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and de-  
send the same to the said ~~John Davis and Lucy Davis~~

and ~~our~~ heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawfu<sup>l</sup> claims and demands of all persons.  
And I, Lucy Davis, of

wife of said John Davis, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby re-  
lease and relinquish unto the said part, of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
