

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

RECORDED

WITH CLAUSES ATTACHED OR DRAFTED

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 29th day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between John Eager, of the first part, and John Morrow, of the second part,

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars (\$200) DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do ~~else~~ hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: ~~more than half (1/2) of the south west quarter 1/4 and the said west quarter (1/4 of the said west quarter) of Section Twenty-six (26) Township eighteen (18) North Range Fourteen (14) East of the Canadian Base and meridian of the Indian Territory containing One hundred Twenty acres (120)~~ together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said John Morrow and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said John Eager and his heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said John Morrow and his heirs, successors and assigns, that he lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that he has good right to sell and convey the same to said John Morrow and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, wife of said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
