

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH ATTACHMENT OF DOWER

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 27 day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seven
 by and between Clara Big Arrow and her husband both of
 Broken Arrow, I part of the first part, and J.W. Simmons
 of Broken Arrow, part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
 One and no/100 DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the

Muske or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: East half of the north-east quarter of Section three (3) township seventeen (17) North Range thirteen (13) east to the north-east quarter of south-east quarter of Section three (3) Township Seventeen (17) North Range Thirteen (13) east of the Indian Base and meridian together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon to be owing or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said J.W. Simmons and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said Clara Simmons for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said J.W. Simmons and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said J.W. Simmons as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said J.W. Simmons and his successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, wife of said J.W. Simmons, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby lease and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
