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GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF POWER

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THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this fifth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Colayton Brunner and Columbia Brunner, his wife, of Muskogee, Okla., part of the first part, and P. E. Heckman of Muskogee, Okla., part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the

Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The East Half (1/2) of the North West Quarter (1/4), and the North West Quarter (1/4) of the North West Quarter (1/4) of section Twenty Four (24), Township Eighteen (18) North and Range Thirteen (13) East

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunitias thereon belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises of the said P. E. Heckman and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said P. E. Heckman for and his heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said P. E. Heckman and his heirs, successors and assigns, that he is lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that he has good right to sell and convey the same to said P. E. Heckman and his heirs, successors and assigns; and that he will and his successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said P. E. Heckman and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Colayton Brunner, of the wife of said Colayton Brunner, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
