GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 9th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and Seven, by and between Maggie Bernore and Le Harlie Bernore, her husband, of the Indian Territory, part, of the first part, and John Shellenberger, of the Indian Territory, part, of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part, of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty One Hundred

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do, hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part, of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The West one-half of the South West Quarter
of Section 1, Township 17 North, range 13 East.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises o the said John Shellenberger
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we the said Maggie Bernore and Le Harlie Bernore

for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said John Shellenberger

and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that

they are free from all incumbrance; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said John

Shellenberger, as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said John Shellenberger

and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawfull claims and demands of all persons.

And I, wife of said John Shellenberger, of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part, of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
