GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH EQUITY OF PURCHASE

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 11th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between Thompson Colbert, brother and sole heir of William Colbert deceased, and Ellen Colbert, his wife, of Muskogee, Okla., part 1st of the first part, and Commercial Land Company, a company,

of Muskogee, Okla., part 2nd of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That that the said part 1st of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other valuable consideration.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 2nd of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the

Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The North-West Quarter (N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-Two (22) Township Nineteen North (T. 19 N.) Range Twelve (12) East, containing 40 acres more or less and being a part of the alluvium exclusive of the homestead of William Colbert deceased, and the South-West Quarter (S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) of the North-West Quarter (N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-Two (22) Township Nineteen (T. 19 N.) Range twelve (12) East containing 40 acres more or less, and being the together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereto, or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Commercial Land Company and its heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said Thompson Colbert, brother and sole heir of William Colbert, deceased and Ellen Colbert, his wife, and heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said

Commercial Land Company and its heirs, successors and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said Commercial Land Company as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Commercial Land Company and its heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawfull claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Ellen Colbert, wife of Thompson Colbert, of Carfunkle, Okla., for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 2nd of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
