GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 10 day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven by and between Warley and Mary Warley his wife of Leoveta, D. T. part 1st of the first part, and Palo Alto Land Company a corporation, of Maskege D. T. part 2d of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part 1st of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of \$4,000.00 Four Thousand DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 2d of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: North Half of the South East Quarter and South West of the South East Quarter of Section Nine (9) Township Nineteen (19) Range Thirteen (13) containing 120 acres South Half of the South West Quarter of Section Fifteen (15) Township Eighteen (18) Range Thirteen (13) E Being the allotment of Louis Loler, (Deceased) together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereon or in anywise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said Palo Alto Land Company and its heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said Warley and Mary Warley his wife for themselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Palo Alto Land Company and its heirs, successors and assigns, that we lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances whatsoever that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title to said premises unto the said Palo Alto Land Company and its heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Mary Warley of Leoveta, D. T. wife of said Warley, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part 2d of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
