

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF CIVIL

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 8th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven
and between John Tigen & Louisa Tigen, his wife
Morris, Okla., Tex., part of the first part, and Robert W. Wright of Muskogee
Okla., Tex., part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part, of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00)
and other valuable consideration, DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part, of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: *The West Half (½) of the
South West Quarter (¼) and the North East Quarter (¼) of the
South West Quarter (¼), Sections 11, 12, 13, 14, Township 26, North Range*

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities therein belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Robert W. Wright
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we the said John Tigen and Louisa Tigen
and his wife and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Robert W. Wright
and his heirs, successors and assigns, that we lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that
they are free from all incumbrance; that we have good right to sell and convey the same to said Robert W.
Wright
as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Robert W. Wright
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Louisa Tigen, wife of said John Tigen, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part, of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
