GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH AN ENDORSEMENT OF SAWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 9 day of Aug., one thousand nine hundred and seven, by and between William Billy, of Cimarron, party of the first part, and R. E. Cooks, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred & ~~Two~~ DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: East half of southwest quarter and south west quarter of south east quarter of section 13, Thirtieth Township (17), Range (14) Northern

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said R. E. Cooks, and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and to the said William Billy, for myself and for my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said R. E. Cooks, and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises, that they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said R. E. Cooks, as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said R. E. Cooks, and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Sarah Billy, wife of said William Billy, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do her by release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
