GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF MONEY

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 13th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and eleven,  
by and between Sam L. Maynard,  
of Okmulgee, Okl., part of the first part, and John L. Maynard,  
of Okmulgee, part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part, of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other  
valuable considerations, DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,  
do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part, of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the  
Muscogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the South west Quarter of Section 3,  
Township 18 North and Range 14 East of the principal  
Base and Meridian in the Indian Territory.

together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurteuances and immunities thereon belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said John L. Maynard  
and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and I the said Sam L. Maynard  
for myself and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said John L. Maynard  
and his heirs, successors and assigns, that claim lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that  
they are free from all incumbrance, that have good right to sell and convey the same to said John L.  
Maynard as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said John L. Maynard  
and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, wife of said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part, of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
