

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF POWER

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 14th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and Seven, by and between Alberd Tiger, of Oklahoma, part, of the first part, and Joseph E. Burke, of Tulsa, Okl., part, of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part, of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do, hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part, of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: The South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty One (21), and the West half of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty Two, Township Nineteen (19) North and Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian in the Indian Territory, and containing 160 acres, more or less, together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said party of the second part and his heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and of the said Alberd Tiger, for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Joseph E. Burke and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said Joseph E. Burke as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Joseph E. Burke and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, Dicey Tiger, wife of said Alberd Tiger, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
