THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 10th day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seventy,

of Muskogee, et al part Y of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part Y of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred (\$900)

DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do as hereby grant, bargan, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part Y of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North east quarter of the northeast quarter of Section Thirty-four, Township Nineteen North of (9) Range twelve (12) East of Indian River and Meridian and the North one-half of the North West one-quarter of Section (32) Thirty-two, Township Nineteen North of Range Twelve (12) East Indian River and Meridian together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said part Y of the second part and his administrators, executors, assigns, heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and the said Sam Company for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said W. D. Cornelius and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises, that they are free from all incumbrance, as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said W. D. Cornelius and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And el wife of said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said part Y of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
