GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 14<sup>th</sup> day of August, one thousand nine hundred and Seven, by and between Susie Pigeon, of Muskogee, Indian Territory, part of the first part, and Bragdon Ford Bulison Company of Muskogee, part of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and fifty dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do I hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the India Territory, to wit: South-East one quarter of South-West one quarter of Section Nineteen, Township Twenty-Three, North, Range Thirteen East.

to have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Bragdon Ford Bulison Company and its heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and of the said Susie Pigeon and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Bragdon Ford Bulison Company and its heirs, successors and assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to said Bragdon Ford Bulison Company as aforesaid; and that I will and my successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Bragdon Ford Bulison Company and its heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
