

GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the undersigned,

THIS INDENTURE. Made and entered into this day of August, one thousand nine hundred and eleven
 by and between Bernie Allwhite, her at law of Garrison Wallace deceased,
Levanta A. T., part 1, of the first part, and Commercial Land Company,
Corporation, of Muskogee, Okla., part 2, of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That that the said part 1, of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other
valuable consideration,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part 2, of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in the
 Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to wit: All the right, title and interest
in and to the South east Quarter (S.E. 1/4) of the South east
Quarter (S.E. 1/4) of Section eight (8) Township seventeen (17) North,
Range fourteen (14) East and containing 40 acres more or less
according to the official survey thereof, and being the homestead
of Garrison Wallace deceased
 together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereto be ongoing or in any wise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Commercial Land Company,
 and its heirs and successors, in fee simple forever; and we, the said Bernie Allwhite, her at law of Garrison
Wallace deceased, for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Commercial Land
Company and its heirs, successors and assigns, that we lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that
they are free from all incumbrance; that we have a good right to sell and convey the same to said
Commercial Land Company,
 as aforesaid; and that we will and our successors, heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Commercial Land Company,
 and its heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I, the wife of said, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do her by release and relinquish unto the said part 2, of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
