THIS INDENTURE, Made this 25th day of May A. D., 1922 between

WITNESSETH: That in consideration of the sum of Thirty-three Hundred Twenty-five and no/100
DOLLARS,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part Y of the first part, do ES by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part Y
of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma,
to-wit:

The North Half of Lot Seven, and the West Fifteen feet of the North
half of Lot Six, except the North Seventeen and on half feet which is used as
a public highway, all in Block one Twin Cities Sub Division in the Southeast
Quarter of Section, Six, Township Nineteen North, Range Twelve East, Tulsa
County, Oklahoma, being the same property I purchased from Elizabeth Dyer.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
wise appertaining, forever.

And said Luna N. Campbell
heirs, executors or administrators, do ES hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part Y of the second part, that at the delivery of
these presents she lawfully seized in her
own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the
appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments,
taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT

Oil, Gas and Mineral rights and mortgage to United Savings and Loan
Association of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the sum of Nine hundred Dollars, dated
October 19th 1921

and that She will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said part Y of the second part, her heirs and assigns, against
said part Y of the first part, her heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the
same.
