DOLLARS,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part V of the first part, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part V of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Twenty Two (22) in Block Twelve (12) in the Townsite
of Turley Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, according to the
recorded plat thereof.

(Party of the first part expressly reserves unto himself,
his heirs and assigns, forever, the oil, gas and minerals and all oil, gas and mineral
rights thereunder incident or appertaining thereto, including the right to drill and prospect
therefor on property adjacent to or in the same vicinity and also to lay and maintain under
the surface of the property herein conveyed all necessary shackles rods and pipe lines for
the purpose of prospecting for and producing the same upon property or properties in the
same vicinity or adjacent thereto, but agrees that no well shall be drilled on the property
conveyed in this deed.

appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments,
taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT

The above described land is not now and never has been any part of grantor's
homestead.

and that he will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said part V of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against
said part V of the first part, his heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the
same.
