these presents that he lawfully seized in his

appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments,  
taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT

Oil, gas and mineral rights are hereby reserved unto the party of the first part,  
and same shall have the right to enter upon, operate and remove the same also  
Subject to Taxes.

said part V of the first part, his heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same.
