the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part Y of the first part, do SS by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part Y  
of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma,  
to-wit:

Beginning at a point thirty Two (32) rods South and twenty  
Rods (20) west of the Northeast (NE) corner of the Southeast  
Quarter (SE Qr. of Sec. (5) Five Township Nineteen (19) North,  
Range Twelve (12) East, thence running twenty(20) rods west,  
thence four (4) rods south thence Twenty (20) rods east thence,  
four (4) rods North to the place of beginning comprising one half  
( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) acre more or less.

these presents that she lawfully seized in her  
own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the  
appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments,  
taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT

One certain mortgage in the sum of One Thousand five Hundred (\$1500.00) dollars,  
with interest at the rate of 10% principal due two years from making thereof.

and that she will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said part Y of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against  
said part Y, of the first part, her heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same.
