TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, forever.

And said W. J. Carl and Evelyn B. Carl husband and wife their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2nd of the second part that at the delivery of these presents that they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT

A first mortgage in favor of the Midland Savings & Loan

Association of Denver Colorado in the amount of \$3200.00

and that they will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said part 2nd of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against said part 1st of the first part, their heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
