the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part 1st of the first part, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part Y
of the second part, and its heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma,

Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Sixteen (16) Township
Twenty (20) North Range Thirteen (13) East of the
Indian Base Meridian containing forty (40) acres
mor or less all in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
wise appertaining, forever.

And said Harry C. Tyrrell and Maud K. Tyrrell his wife for their
heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part Y of the second part, that at the delivery of
these presents that they are lawfully seized in their
own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the
appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments,
taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT

and that they will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said part Y of the second part, and its heirs and assigns, against
said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the
same.
